What is the Scholarship?

The Engineers' Society of Saint Paul (ESSP) provides scholarship to students who are pursuing engineering or engineering-related degrees in the next academic semester.

ESSP will award two \$1,000 scholarships for the 2019 Spring Semester.

Do you qualify?

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Are currently enrolled in an engineering or engineering-related degree program through the spring 2019 semester.
- Are registered for a minimum of 12 credits for the spring 2019 semester.
- Are sponsored by an active member of ESSP.

Applications must be postmarked or received by Tuesday, January 9th, 2019.

Applications may be obtained by contacting any ESSP officer.

How is the selection made?

The ESSP Scholarship Committee reviews applications. The Scholarship Committee takes into consideration the following items in making its decisions:

- Interest in the field of engineering
- Academic performance (also considering credit load, work history, etc...)
- Financial need
- Personal statement

What is ESSP?

ESSP is an organization of professional engineers who work in and around the City of Saint Paul. Meetings are held the second Tuesday of every month (Sept-May) at the TKDA (444 Cedar Street) in downtown St. Paul. The meetings are followed by a diverse engineering program, which are worth 1 PDH.
